## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS


- Dispose of plastic bag from packaging and do not allow children to play with it.


- The lamp is only intended for interior use.
- Lamp shade gets hot after prolonged use.
- Do not place the cable in reach of small children or anywhere there is a risk of falling over it.

# CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

The Bellevue lamp is made from solid brass and lacquered aluminum. The brass used is uncoated and will therefore develop a unique and beautiful patina over time. To ensure the lamp will look beautiful for years to come, please only use a dry soft cloth to clean the lamp. Never use aggressive detergents or abrasive cleaning agents as this will damage the surface of the lamp.







#### **STEP 1**

The lamp accepts standard screw mount bulbs:



Maximum 40 W. E14 bulb.

#### **STEP 2**

Use the flexible swan-neck to set the shade at a desired angle. It is best to set the angle before turning the lamp on as the shade gets hot when the lamp is in use for longer periods of time.
