

STUB

Wood and glass merge smoothly within this unique table design. Inspired by a wooden 'stump', Stub (means 'stump' in Danish) the clear glass circle floats around the veneer base.

DESIGNER

Danish Architect Mette Schelde's work takes its starting point in function and everyday situations. She creates lighting and furniture both as one-offs as well as industrial designs for production. Stub™ is her first design produced by Fritz Hansen and was originally part of the Crossovers Exhibition in London (2019).

MATERIAL

Tabletop: The tabletop is 10 mm low iron, fully tempered float glass.

Base: The wooden coloumn base is made from a birch plywood core and one layer of exterior veneer available in 3 different surface finishes.

Materials in %:

Glass 50%, Plywood 50%

Items with a weight <1% of the total product weight are not included in the figures.

BASES

The wooden base is available in 3 variants:



PRODUCTION PROCESS

Tabletop: The glass tabletop is made from low iron, fully tempered float glass and is integrated in the base with no visible screws or mounting and no glue used.

Base: The hollow base is made from two base halves made from form-pressed birch plywood with an exterior veneer.

MADE-TO-ORDER

Non-standard configurations (e.g. special colours) are available upon request at a minimum order quantity.

PACKAGING

The table is covered with a plastic bag and shipped in a cardboard box with genuine foam inside. All packaging material can be recycled.

CLEANING AND CARE

Glass: Tabletops made of glass should be wiped with a clean, dry cloth. Clean with regular window/glass cleaner and a soft cloth. Never spray directly onto the product - always spray onto the cloth.

Veneer: Wipe the furniture with a clean cloth. Stains and dirt can be removed from the furniture with a clean cloth wrung in water, or in a solution of hot water and a universal cleaning detergent (ammonia acceptable), soap flakes (1/4 dl (decilitre) soap flakes for 1 litre hot water, cooled), a washing detergent or hot water with about 10% vinegar. Finally, wipe off the table top with a clean, dry cloth.

REPAIR, DISPOSAL AND REUSE

In case of repair and disposal the table can be disassembled into different parts. All parts can be disassembled and sorted for recycling. Check local regulations for recycling options and whether there is potential for reuse.

WARRANTY

Fritz Hansen provides a five-year warranty on standard products against defects in materials and workmanship.


