MUUTO LAUNCHES LOFT CHAIR, A NEW INDUSTRIAL-INSPIRED DESIGN BY THOMAS BENTZEN

Inspired by life's everyday requirements, designer Thomas Bentzen's Loft Chair for Muuto exemplifies honest, simple design.

Contrasting materials and careful attention to detail form the foundation of Loft. Its solid, powder coated steel frame is offset with the warmth of plywood, moulded to embrace the user's body. In a nostalgic nod to industrial design, the cast frame—with larger back legs for added strength—is welded to lend stability and durability to the chair. Visible screws further enhance the engineered feel.

Exploring the limitations of materials, the wood seat and backrest are curved to create proportions that aid the functional yet sophisticated chair to benefit any setting with maximum comfort.

"The steel frame features simple joints and welds, lending a precise and solid appearance to the chair. The curved seat and backrest contrast this, making the Loft Chair very human and comfortable."

A former designer at Studio Louise Campbell, Thomas Bentzen started his own studio in 2010. He is the co-founder of the design collective Remove, and his products have received international recognition at fairs and exhibitions across the world.
